What does it cost?

Your school district offers these elective programs as they do all others, at little or no tuition cost to you. Some course and/or lab fees may be required to cover uniforms, tools, and personal items.

How do I get there?

Your school will provide bus transportation to and from LACC.

What about credits?

LACC currently offers two credits per year per course. All credits accumulate toward graduation requirements and may be used at some colleges to meet entrance requirements. Dual credit courses can gain you college credit at Heartland Community College or Joilet Junior College and/ or advanced placement.
